INTRODUCTION

Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing, located in Odakkali, Asamannoor P.O., Perumbavoor, is an educational institution operated under the auspices of the Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust, Nellikkuzhi, Kothamangalam. The Trust was established in 2001 under the Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust, facilitating the establishment of various educational institutions in fields such as Engineering, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Arts & Science, Polytechnic, and Paramedical studies, all of which have been operating successfully.

The College offers the B.Sc. Nursing course, approved by the Government of Kerala (G.O (MS) No. 230/2023/ H&FWD Dated 24.08.2023), affiliated with the Indian Nursing Council (INC), Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC), Trivandrum and Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Trissur. The annual student intake for B.Sc. Nursing course is 60. The institution is located 10 kilometres from Kothamangalam town.

Nursing course at Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing, Odakkali, Asamannoor P.O, Perumbavoor, for the academic year 2024-2025. The rules herein are subject to additions, deletions, or modifications as deemed necessary, in accordance with orders from competent authorities or courts.

OVERVIEW OF B.Sc. NURSING

The B.Sc. Nursing degree program is a four-year full-time program comprising eight semesters, as specified by the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), approved by Indian Nursing Council (INC). This program prepares B.Sc. Nursing graduates to practice nursing and midwifery in various public/government or private healthcare settings.

Number of Seats: 60 Seats per Year Management Quota: 30 seats (50% of Total Seats)

• **Government Quota:** 30 seats (50% of Total Seats)

ALLOTMENT OF SEATS

Government Quota:

- The Government quota consists of 30 seats (50% of Total Seats).
- These seats are allocated by the Director of Medical Education based on merit.
- The admission process for the government merit seats (50%) at Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing is conducted by the Director, LBS Centre for Science & Technology, under the supervision of the Director of Medical
- Education, in accordance with G.O (MS) No. 230/2023/H&FWD dated 24/08/2023.

Management Quota:

- The Management quota also consists of 30 seats (50% of Total Seats).
- These seats are allocated by Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing.
- There are no reservations applicable to the Management seats.
- Candidates are required to pay the tuition fees and special fees as fixed by the Government
- The eligibility for admission is same as for general merit and the candidate will be selected on merit basis

Eligibility for Admission:

Candidates seeking admission to the B.Sc. Nursing course must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must have passed the higher secondary examinations of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Government of Kerala, or any equivalent examination recognized by the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), with a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English combined.
- Candidates should have completed 17 years of age by 31st December 2024. Proof of
 age must be provided in the form of a self-attested copy of the relevant page of the
 School Record (such as SSLC/CBSE/ICSE certificate) or a copy of the birth
 certificate issued by the appropriate authority, submitted along with the application
 form.
- Applicants who have passed their qualifying examination from universities/boards outside Kerala must provide an eligibility certificate from universities/boards concerned

DURATION

The B.Sc. Nursing course spans four years and follows a credit and semester-based structure, comprising eight semesters inclusive of 6 months (8th semester) Internship. The maximum duration permitted to successfully complete the B.Sc. Nursing course shall not exceed twice the actual duration of the course (eight years).

HOW TO APPLY

- The application for admission and the prospectus are available online on the college website. Visit the website for details.
- The application fee is Rs. 2000/- for all candidates, payable online via Credit/Debit/Internet Banking.
- Applicants must have a valid email ID.
- After filling out all necessary information and uploading required marks and documents, candidates can pay the application fee online.
- The application submission will only be considered complete after successful payment of the application fee online.
- Upon successful submission and payment, candidates will receive an electronically generated receipt at their registered email address.
- After submitting the application online, candidates should print a copy which must be submitted to the Principal, Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing during the admission interview.
- Each applicant may submit the application online only once
- The application fee once paid is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- Enclose self-attested copies of the following certificates with the application form:
 - 1. S.S.L.C Certificate/Equivalent/Birth Certificate
 - 2. Plus Two Certificate/Equivalent (with mark list)
 - 3. Nativity Certificate
 - 4. Course Certificate issued by the Head of the Educational Institution last attended
 - 5. Copy of Transfer Certificate (TC) and Conduct Certificate.
 - 6. Copy of Equivalency Certificate and Migration Certificate (Only for candidates from outside Kerala).
 - 7. Copy of Application Fee Payment Details for Admission.
 - 8. Caste Certificate and Income Certificate (for candidates eligible for reservation benefits such as SC/ST/OBC/OEC/EBW, etc.).
 - 9. Four Passport Size Photographs.
- Incomplete or late applications will be rejected.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

Selection of candidates will be based on a merit list prepared from marks obtained in the Plus Two or qualifying examination. Candidates must bring all original documents for verification during admission. Providing false information will result in admission cancellation.

Preparation of Merit List

- Marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English in the Higher Secondary Examination* will determine the merit list. In the event of a tie among students, priority will be given to higher marks in Biology, followed by Physics and Chemistry. If ties persist after this criterion, the candidate's Date of Birth will be taken into consideration, with preference given to older candidates
- CBSE/ICSE Senior Secondary Examination marks will be equated with Kerala syllabus Higher Secondary marks through an approved normalization process.

Publication of Rank List

Rank lists will be published on the college website www.igmcn.org on the specified date.

ADMISSION

Selected candidates will be notified of the interview and admission dates via the website. Candidates should regularly visit the Official Website of Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing for updates and notifications. Candidates selected under the Management quota must deposit fees into the designated bank account.

- All selected students must be vaccinated against Hepatitis B before admission. Certificates must be provided at admission or before the course begins.
- A Physical Fitness Certificate, certified by a Registered Medical Practitioner, must be submitted at admission or before the course commencement.

COURSE FEES

The fee structure for the academic year 2025 is set by the Government/Fee Regulatory Committee.

Any revisions for the current academic year must be paid by the candidate. Annual fee is payable at the beginning of academic year during each year of the course on or before 30th September. Caution Deposit is refundable after the completion of course on submission of Non-Liability Certificate (NLC).

DISCONTINUATION

Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent "Civil Court".

EXAMINATIONS

Regular University Examinations are held at the end of each semester, with supplementary exams scheduled as per Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) notifications. Examination fees must be paid by candidates as specified by the University.

ELIGIBILITY FOR EXAMINATION APPEARANCE

- Candidate should have minimum of 80% attendance in theory and practical per subject is required for appearing in University Examinations. Non-exam going subjects also require a minimum 80% attendance to register for examination. If a candidate has less than 80% attendance in any subject, they will not be eligible to appear for examinations in that semester.
- Candidates must achieve at least 50% marks in internal assessments for theory and practical's (where applicable) to qualify for University Examinations. The minimum passing mark is 40% for Communicative English and Elective modules.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

College

- 1. Students must adhere to professional conduct and maintain high standards of discipline.
- 2. Decorum and dignity must be maintained in the College, Hospital, and Hostel.
- 3. The management reserves the right, as per Clause 7 of University Rules and Regulations and judgments of the Courts, to halt student organizational activities on campus.
- 4. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited; severe action will be taken as per Supreme Court directives.
- 5. Use of mobile phones during class, clinics, or working hours is strictly prohibited; confiscated devices will not be returned.
- 6. Use of drugs, smoking, alcohol consumption, etc., is strictly prohibited in class, compounds, clinics, and hostels, with violations leading to dismissal.
- 7. Any form of in disciplinary behaviour (whistling, passing comments, displaying posters, spreading rumours, shouting, etc.,) towards teachers, students, or staff is intolerable and will result in severe disciplinary action.
- 8. Changes in contact information must be promptly reported to the College; the College bears no responsibility for communication delays due to unreported address changes.
- 9. The institution is not liable for communication delays or losses due to postal or courier service failures.

- 10. Students must arrive punctually for class or clinical duties; latecomers will not be admitted.
- **11.** Absences require timely notification to the class coordinator or relevant teacher, with absenteeism without prior notice not appreciated.

Uniform

Students must strictly adhere to the dress code specified by the institution in class and clinical settings.

Hostel

- Hostel facilities are available for students. Monthly hostel fees amount to Boys-₹
 6,250/-, Girls -₹ 6,250/- subject to market price fluctuations.
- Hostel admission is subject to availability; yearly hostel fees must be paid before each academic year.
- Hostel establishment fees amount to ₹ 15,000 (One Time).
- Hostel caution deposits (₹ 1,000) and admission fees (₹ 1,000)
- Subject to Hostel Policy compliance by all inmates.

Mess Facility

- Hostel residents have access to mess facilities.
- Monthly dues payable before the 5th of each subsequent month.
